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FOOD VENDORS:

- Each food vendor must use an approved commercial kitchen.
- Food Vendors will only sell food items that have been listed on your application.
 - * Health permits for food vendors must be obtained from the Department of Health Sanitation Branch, 591 Ala Moana Blvd.
- Permits need to be reviewed and approved by Festival Staff.
- Health permits must be displayed during the Festival
- First come first basis
- Complete food menus must be submitted to the Festival Committee by 09/15/2026
- Vendors must display menus at the Festival
- You must also provide own washing hand station and trash bags

NO DRINKS INCLUDING SODA, WATER OR ANY OTHER BEVERAGES ARE NOT TO BE SOLD

ALL VENDORS:

- All vendors must provide their own tents with weights **ONLY**, tables and chairs
- Set up on the day of the event starts at 8am.
- You must be ready to open at 11:45am
- All vendors must keep their own area clean and orderly throughout the day.
- Vendors must clean and vacate their area by 11:00pm on October 10th
- If the vendor area is not cleaned to satisfaction Vendor will be charged an additional "Cleaning Fee" of \$200.00.
- Vendors must not clean any equipment at the festival.
- All trash must be bagged and discarded in the open roll-off trash bin provided by Hispanic Festival.
- Each site must be completely cleaned prior to vacating the area.

LOGISTICS:

- Vendors/Exhibitors will be assigned a designated area for setup.
- Tents for your booth must be set-up on Friday Oct. 9th from 3:00pm-7:00pm
- NO VEHICLES will be permitted on the festival area before, during or after the festival.
- A total of 4 entry wristbands will be distributed to all Vendors on the day of the event. • Private security is available on the day of the event.

Vendor Agreement

In honor of Hispanic Heritage Month, we present the Hispanic Heritage Festival & Health Fair.

I, _____, representing _____ as a vendor, acknowledge that it is our responsibility to clean and restore our area to its original state before leaving the festival grounds. Vendors must clean and vacate their booth area by 11:00pm on October 10th (no exceptions). Failure to clean the vendor area to satisfaction will result in an additional "Cleaning Fee" of \$200.00. All trash must be bagged and disposed of in the open roll-off trash bin provided by the Hispanic Festival. Each site must be thoroughly cleaned before vacating the area.

Attention food vendors: You are required to provide your own wash station and trash bags.

Each vendor is responsible for removing their own waste cooking oil, cooking products, and leftover food. Any cooking waste left on-site by the vendor during and after the festival will incur a charge of **\$750.00 per occurrence**. Vendors are not permitted to clean any equipment at the festival.

If, for any reason, the Hispanic Festival committee incurs expenses or must clean your area after we depart, I agree to pay the stated fees to the committee within one week by **SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2025**.
